#### The Wonderful Wallaby

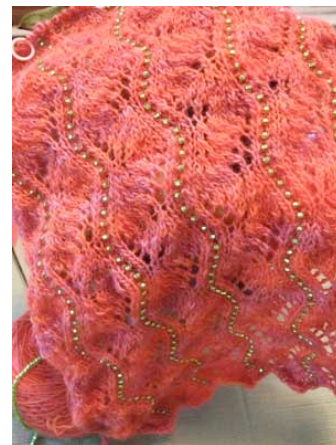


A longtime favorite, this hooded pullover is knit all in one piece with sizes ranging from child's small to adult extra-large. Easy and fun to knit!
