Fall 2009 Knit-Along Projects

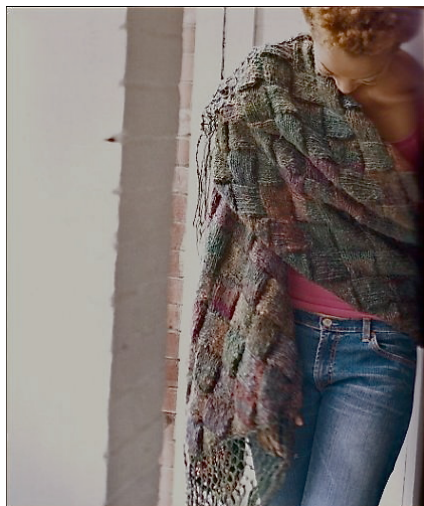
A Knit-Along is a group of folks working on the same project with the help, guidance and encouragement of all the other participants.
